*Major:* Business Management & Marketing with a Minor in Human Resources.

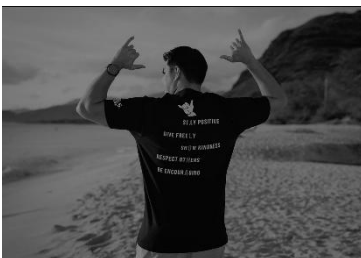
